The Visiting Committee's Confidential Recommendation to the Commission on Accreditation:

	<u>Six Years Clear</u> (6CL) – A full six-year term of accreditation with a written progress report on school improvement action plans and major recommendations submitted to the Union Office of Education.
	<u>Six Years with an Interim Review</u> (6IR) – A full six-year term of accreditation with annual submission of a written progress report on school improvement action plans and major recommendations AND an on-campus Interim Review visit. (6IR-3) – IR visits should occur at the mid-term, the third year of accreditation. (6IR-2/4) – In special cases, IR visits may be recommended to occur in the second and fourth years of accreditation.
	<u>Revisit</u> (RV) <u>Three Year Term with a Revisit</u> (3RV) – A term of three years with annual submission of a written progress report on school improvement action plans and all recommendations AND an on-campus Revisit. Revisits will occur in the third and last year of the term of accreditation. <u>Two Year Term with a Revisit</u> (2RV) – A term of two years with annual submission of a written progress report on school improvement action plans and all recommendations AND an on-campus Revisit. Revisits will occur in the second and last year of the term of accreditation.
	<u>Probation</u> (PB) – A school may be placed on probation for one or two years. See the options below: (PB-1) – One-Year Probation: There is evidence that the school has not met the Standards of Accreditation criteria in one or more critical areas. Provide the rationale for the accreditation status recommendation in the Justification Statement. A Revisit at the end of the year of probation shall result in either a maximum term of three years or denial of accreditation. (PB-2) – Two-Year Probation: There is evidence that the school has not met the Standards of Accreditation criteria in one or more critical areas with the recognition that improvements may take up to two years. Provide the rationale for the accreditation status recommendation in the Justification Statement. There will be a Revisit at the end of the term with an allowance for a special review visit after the first year of this two-year probationary term to assess progress as may be deemed appropriate and approved by the Commission. This Revisit shall result in a maximum term of three years or denial of accreditation.
	<u>Accreditation Denied</u> (AD) – Denial of accreditation would be based on evidence that the school does not or could not reasonably meet the Criteria for Accreditation. This action would initiate a review of the school's official standing as a denominational institution.

NOTE: When the evaluation is a joint visit with a regional accrediting association every effort will be made to ensure coterminous accreditation. In no case shall the term exceed six years.
