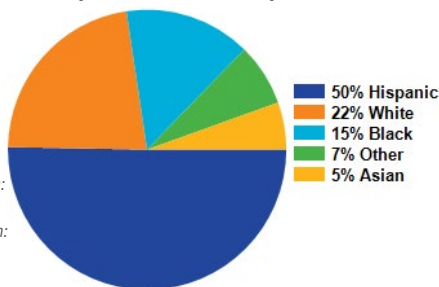

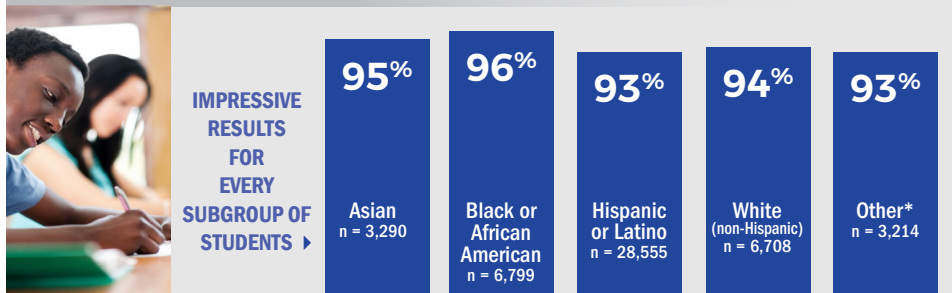

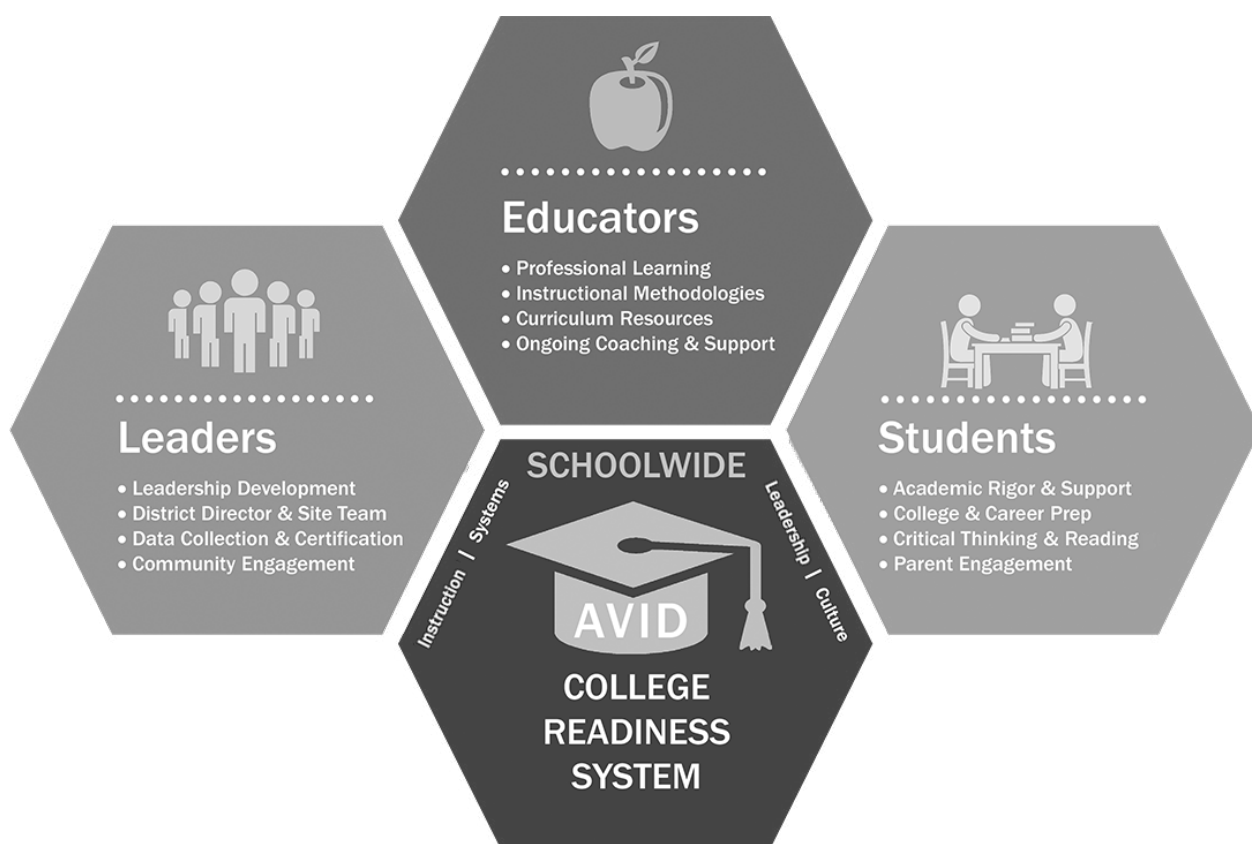

The AVID College Readiness System

AVID is a college readiness system designed to increase the number of students who enroll and persist in four-year colleges and universities. The AVID College Readiness System (ACRS) incorporates three distinct components: AVID Elementary, AVID Secondary (AVID Elective), and AVID for Higher Education.

Each component addresses the specific needs of students to help bridge the path from elementary school through higher education completion. For almost 40 years, AVID has accelerated student learning, used research-based methods of effective instruction, provided meaningful and motivational professional learning, and acted as a catalyst for systemic reform and change.

AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) has proven time and time again that, when given resources and tools for academic rigor and support, virtually all students can be academically successful. AVID Center’s vision for the future is to provide the entire educational system, elementary through higher education, with a comprehensive feeder-pattern model focused on success for all students within a rigorous academic setting.
